Dual Enrollment



- Students who have not graduated from high school but are interested in taking college courses that could be applied toward their high school graduation are considered dual enrolled students.
- The Dual Enrollment Program offers students the opportunity to earn college credit before high school graduation.

Dual Enrollment Eligibility



You must:

- be a high school junior or senior.
- submit an application for dual enrollment to TCC or FSU.
- have a 3.0 unweighted high school grade point average (GPA) to attend TCC or a 3.5 unweighted GPA to attend FSU.
- have qualifying SAT, ACT or CPT (College Placement Test) scores in the verbal areas; students who want to take college level math classes must also have appropriate test scores in Math.
- have written permission from WHS before signing up for courses at the college. A new permission form must be submitted each semester you are dual enrolled at TCC or FSU.

Dual Enrollment Course Availability



Students may take:

- A maximum of two courses per semester (including summer sessions)
- Courses in the areas of Social Science, Social Studies, or Science; however, these courses may not be offered at Wakulla High School.
- Courses offered as dual enrollment on WHS campus in 2009-2010 include:
 - College Success
 - AMH 1040 (Fall) and AMH 1051 (Spring)
