1. If you graduated from college as an education major or you currently hold either a Florida or out-of-state active educator's certificate, apply on line for employment with the School District of Wakulla County, Florida

2. If you do not hold a valid Florida Certificate for full time teaching, apply on line for initial certification with the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Educator's Certification in the subject(s) for which you are seeking employment
